

Chaplain's Corner

Seven Realities of Experiencing God

At Waller Baptist Church, we have been going through the Experiencing God Bible Study. The following is just a quick listing and explanation of the Seven Realities of Experiencing God. If you ever have the opportunity to take this course, please do so. If you do, and apply these truths to your life, your life will be changed!

- 1. God is always at work around you.
 - a. We need to understand that God is everywhere all the time. In other words, He is with you as you go about your day, all day long no matter what you are doing. We see throughout Scriptures that God is always at work; therefore, we can expect God to always be at work around us (Ex. 2:23-25: 23 Now it came about in the course of those many days that the king of Egypt died. And the sons of Israel sighed because of the bondage, and they cried out; and their cry for help because of their bondage rose up to God. 24 So God heard their groaning; and God remembered His covenant with Abraham, Isaac, and Jacob. 25 God saw the sons of Israel, and God took notice of them.

- 2. God pursues a continuing love relationship with you that is real and personal.
 - a. We know that God loves us (John 3:16) and this love is not a static love. That is, He does not love us, then leave us to our own work, but He loves us with an active, continuing, unconditional love. He wants to be with us and for us to love Him back. Notice in Exodus 24:12, God told Moses to "Come up to me on the mountain" and Moses did. God pursued a loving relationship with him.
- 3. God invites you to become involved with Him in His work.
 - a. When we see God working around us, we are invited to become involved with Him. We see this in Exodus 3:8, 10 where God tells Moses that He is sending Moses to Pharaoh so that he could lead the Israelites out of Egypt. In the same way, He invites us to become involved with Him as we see Him at work around us.
- 4. God speaks by the Holy Spirit through the Bible, prayer, circumstances, and the church to reveal Himself, His purposes and His ways.
 - a. In order to "see" what God is doing around us, we need to be tuned in to His voice, the same way that we tune in a radio station to hear the music that we like to listen to. We "tune in" by reading/studying the Bible (which can give us instructions (Go and make disciples), prayer (he will speak to our hearts as we pray), circumstances (He can put someone in our path, or put us in their path), and the church (other members, pastor, etc. can be working with God and that gives us an opportunity to work with Him.) When we listen, we find out that He reveals more about Himself, what He wants us to do and what He is doing.
- 5. God's invitation for you to work with Him always leads you to a crisis of belief that requires faith and action.
 - a. When we see God at work, that is an invitation to join Him in that work. That invitation always leads us to a crisis of belief. That means we must make a decision. Do we or do we not do what God is inviting us to do? Look at Moses, again. When he saw the burning bush and God invited him to join him in freeing the Israelites, he had to make a decision. So anytime we see God at work, do we believe that God can equip us to do that work, or are we so limited in our thinking that we don't think God can equip us? Once we make the decision to join God, we must put our faith in action and follow through with what God is calling us to do. Be aware that what we see God doing one time, may not be the same thing He's asking us to do the next time.
- 6. You must make major adjustments in your life to join God in what He is doing.
 - a. Once we decide to join God in what he is doing, it will require major adjustments. Look at Abram (later Abraham). God told him to pack up all his belongings and family and go where God would show him. He was a rich man and had a lot of possessions. He packed up and followed where God led. Notice that God didn't tell him where he was going. He just said "Go"! Don't you think that Abram had to make some major adjustments in his life to follow God? We need to be prepared to make those same kind of adjustments in our lives to join God in His work. Yes, even if He says "Go"!
- 7. You come to know God by experience as you obey Him, and He accomplishes His work through you.
 - a. As we allow God to accomplish His work through us, we come to experience Him. Once again, look at Abraham. He followed God and God made of him a great nation. God performed many miracles by the hand of Moses. He saved and entire world through the obedience of Jesus, dying on the cross.

What can He do through you? Probably more, much more than you can even imagine! He may not have you do something huge at the very first, but He could build you up little, by little until He does great things through you. Are you willing to watch to see where He is working and join Him? As children of God, we should always be ready and willing to join Him. Just realize that as a Christian, there are two words we should NEVER utter together. "No, Lord." If He is truly our Lord, we cannot say no. Think of that the next time you feel Him leading you to do something.

Reminder Before Riding

Always check the following

- 1. Tire pressure
- 2. Oil levels when engine is hot
- 3. Lights
- 4. Battery terminals
- 5. Nut & bolts are tight
- 6. Brake pads
- 7. Air filter
- 8. Tire wear
- 9. Inspection sticker
- 10. Any leaks
- 11. Chain or belt tension
- 12. Wheel spokes loose or tight
- 13. Battery is fully charged

Remember always check your tire pressure bolts and nuts oil level when engine is hot and battery terminals




