




RECIPE

Crockpot Lasagna Soup



Ingredients

- 1 lbs ground italian sausage browned
- 1 yellow onion diced
- 32 oz chicken broth or beef broth
- = 30 oz petite diced tomatoes
- 6 oz tomato paste
- 2 tbsp minced garlic
- 1 tbsp Italian seasoning
- 1 tsp garlic powder

- 1 tsp onion powder
- ½ tsp salt
- ½ tsp pepper
- 8 uncooked lasagna pasta broken into bite-sized pieces
- ½ cup heavy cream

Topping:

- · 15 oz ricotta cheese
- · 1 cup mozzarella cheese
- ½ cup grated Parmesan
- ½ tsp basil
- · Fresh basil

Preparation

- Add your diced tomatoes and tomato paste into the bottom of your slow cooker.
- Add your browned Italian sausage, and diced yellow onions.
- Season with Italian seasoning, garlic powder, onion powder, salt, pepper, and minced garlic.
- Add your chicken broth, and stir together.
- Cover, and cook on LOW for 6-8 hours, or HIGH for 3-4.
- Thirty minutes before serving, pour in your heavy cream and your broken lasagna pasta. Cover cut your slow cooker on HIGH.
- For the topping, mix together your ricotta, mozzarella, Parmesan cheese, and basil. Set it to the side until your pasta is cooked.
- Serve your soup with a scoop of your ricotta mixture, and fresh basil.



CMA Monthly Bible Study

IS GOD ALWAYS IN CONTROL?

I have had this conversation a few times over the last month. Does man's cooperation effect God's control? There are so many things to consider, like if He is, why do bad things happen, and so on. Let's investigate the scriptures for wisdom.

In thinking about man's cooperation or the lack thereof with God's will, Jonah comes to my mind. God had an assignment for Jonah, but Jonah ran the other way. God went before him and prepared a great fish. Jonah 1:17 (KJV) says, "Now the Lord had prepared a great fish to swallow up Jonah. And Jonah was in the belly of the fish three days and three nights."

That great fish could have been Jonah's end, but because of Jonah's repentance, it became a safe haven to get him where God wanted him instead. God sets life and death before us; Jonah had a choice to die in rebellion. Jonah suffered the consequences of his disobedience being in a filthy, slimy, smelly, confining place. But because he repented, he chose life. God caused the great fish to vomit Jonah on dry land. Although He gave Jonah a choice, it is clear that God remained in control here.

Looking at the happenings of Job, the enemy sought to do evil against Job in testing him. But God was very specific in what He would allow the enemy to do.

Job 1:12 (KJV), "And the Lord said unto satan, behold, all that he hath is in thy power; only upon himself put not forth thine hand. So, satan went forth from the presence of the Lord."

I love that God sets boundaries, and the enemy cannot exceed them. As with creation, everything is under God's authority. Scripture shows us that even the ocean is confined by His control.

Jeremiah 5:22 (KJV), "saith the Lord: will ye not tremble at my presence, which have placed the sand for the bound of the sea by a perpetual decree, that it cannot pass it: and though the waves thereof toss themselves, yet can they not prevail; though they roar, yet can they not pass over it?"

Proverbs 8:29 (KJV), "When he gave to the sea his decree, that the waters should not pass his commandment: when he appointed the foundations of the earth:"

As we look at Jesus, when He stood before Pilate, Pilate contended he had control to execute or set Him free. John 19:10-11 (KJV), "Then saith Pilate unto him, Speakest thou not unto me? Knowest thou not that I have power to crucify thee, and have power to release thee? Jesus answered, Thou couldest have no power at all against me, except it were given thee from above: therefore he that delivered me unto thee hath the greater sin."

Scripture tells us that those who are in authority are placed there by God.

Daniel 2:21 (KJV), "He changes times and the seasons: he removeth kings, and setteth up kings: he giveth wisdom to the wise, and knowledge to them that know understanding:"

Romans 13:1 (KJV), "Let every soul be subject unto the higher powers. For there is no power but God: the powers that be are ordained of God." What is the definition of control? To exercise restraining or directing influence over. That sounds exactly like God. He restrains, and He directs.


If we look at Daniel, God shut the mouths of the lions, but Daniel was still thrown into the den in the midst of them. If we look at the three Hebrew children, the guards were consumed by the same flames that God shielded Shadrack, Meshack, and Abednego from, but they were still thrown in the furnace. God rained hail stones down on the heads of the enemies of Israel (Joshua 10:11), yet the Israelites still had to be in the battle. He parted the Red Sea for His people and closed it upon the enemy (Exodus 14:21-29), yet the children of Israel had to put one step in front of the other, walking through it in faith.

So, is God always in control? We can be assured yes, sometimes in restraint, sometimes directing influence, and sometimes by His mighty hand. If we put our trust in God and believe that His intentions towards us are good (Jeremiah 29:11), when we walk through bad times, tough times, and uncertain times, we can trust that He is in control in whatever form He chooses according to His will and that He will be with us (Deuteronomy 31:6).

- Do you recognize God's control in a bad situation in your own life?
- What attempts do you make to focus on His acts of mercy?
- Can you see Him going before you?
- Has your cooperation or the lack there made a difference in outcomes in your life? How so?

Reminder Before Riding

Always check the following

- 1. Tire pressure
- 2. Oil levels when engine is hot
- 3. Lights
- 4. Battery terminals
- 5. Nut & bolts are tight
- 6. Brake pads
- 7. Air filter
- 8. Tire wear
- 9. Inspection sticker
- 10. Any leaks
- 11. Chain or belt tension
- 12. Wheel spokes loose or tight

Remember always check your tire pressure bolts and nuts oil level when engine is hot and battery terminals
